Wear & Tear

- Regularly check the battery for any **signs of damage, such as bulging or leaking.**
- If any such signs are observed, it would be best to replace the battery.

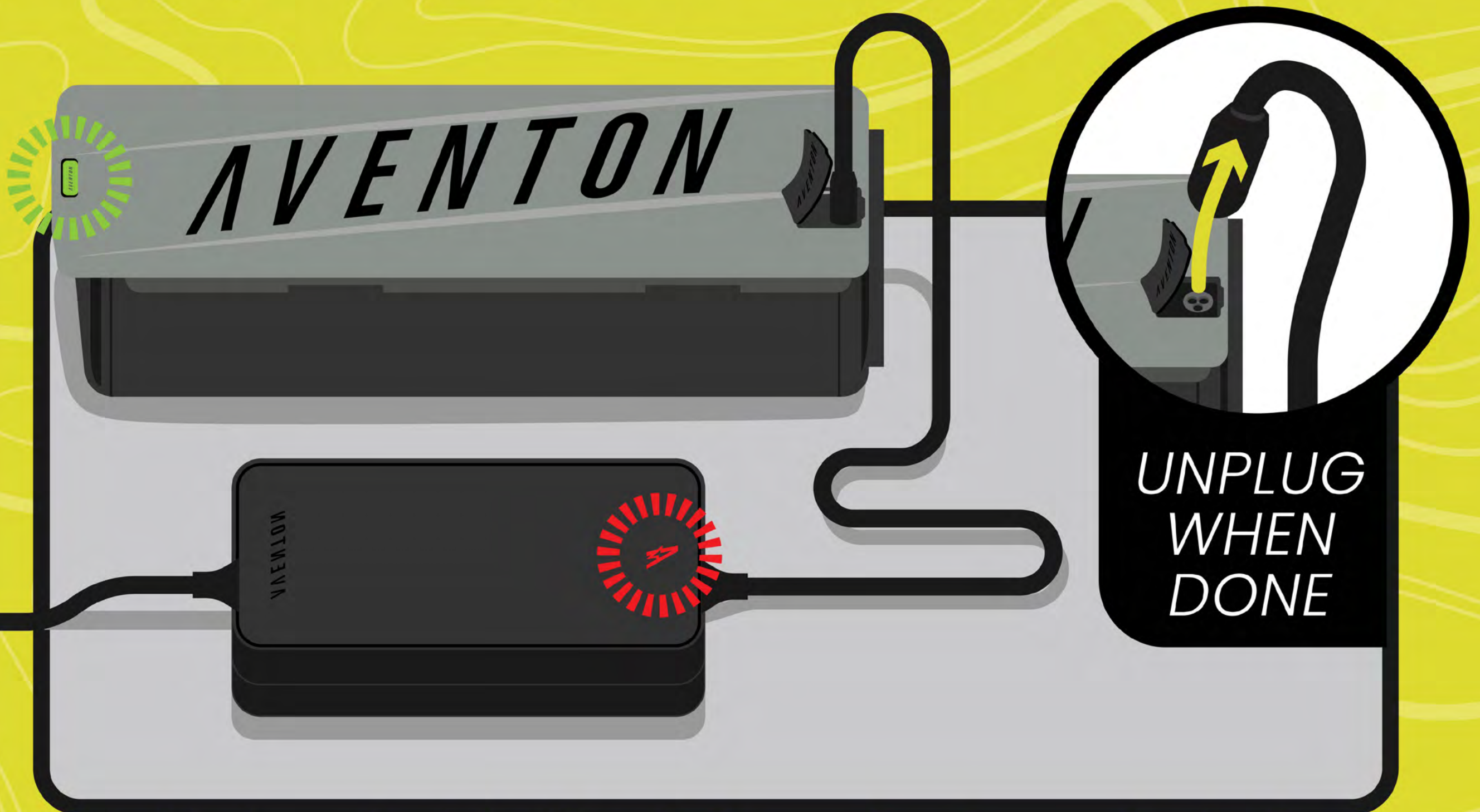

Monitoring Charging

- Don't charge your ebike overnight.
- Unplug your ebike as soon as possible.
- Lights on charger and battery indicate charge up progress.



Avoid Damaging Your Battery



Never puncture or damage the battery, as this can cause a short circuit, or worse, an ebike fire.



Seek Professional Assistance

- Never attempt to open or repair an ebike battery.
- Contents can be dangerous.

Disposing Lithium-ion Batteries

- Damaged and overheating batteries need to be disposed of properly.
- Handle it with extreme caution.
- Check with local fire safety regulations.
